



## ***BALTIC SEA CLUB CUP 2020***

### REGULATION

#### **1. Organization**

- 1.1. The tournament is organized by Estonian Petanque Federation in cooperation with Latvian, Lithuanian, and Finnish federations.
- 1.2. Dates: 30-31 May 2020.
- 1.3. Place: parking area of Fra Mare Thalasso Spa, Haapsalu, Estonia.
- 1.4. List of players representing a club must be sent by email to [bscc@petanque.ee](mailto:bscc@petanque.ee) on May 25th, 2020 the latest.

## 2. Participants

- 2.1. 2 best clubs from Latvian, Lithuanian, Estonian and Finnish federations can participate in the tournament (8 clubs all together).
- 2.2. In case a club or federation can't participate, the place can be offered to another country / federation.
- 2.3. Each club can register up to 8 players, at least 2 of them must be women (e.g. 6 men and 2 women, 5 men 3 women). A club must register 6 players minimum, then only one of them must be a woman.
- 2.4. All players of one team need to wear the same uniform.
- 2.5. There will be maximum of 8 teams / clubs in the tournament.
- 2.6. Smoking and use of mobile devices are prohibited during tournament games; alcohol and drug use is prohibited throughout the tournament.

## 3. Playing system

- 3.1. Round-robin games in 2 groups + play-off.
- 3.2. The sequence of clubs in a group will be drawn before the tournament.

#### **4. Rules**

- 4.1. Games are played according to the FIPJP (Fédération Internationale de Pétanque et Jeu Provençal) approved petanque game rules.
- 4.2. Terrain dimensions must match CEP (Confédération Européenne de Pétanque) EuroCup Qualification Rules (min 13m x 3m).
- 4.3. In the case of a tie game, teams play an extra end.
- 4.4. Time limit for each game is different:
  - Singles - 40 minutes plus additional jack
  - Doubles - 50 minutes plus additional jack
  - Triples - 60 minutes plus additional jack
- 4.5. Before each match both teams / clubs need to record the names of:
  - 4.5.1. In SINGLES 6 players (including at least 1 woman).
  - 4.5.2. In DOUBLES 3 doubles: one mixed (man and woman), and two freely formed doubles.
  - 4.5.3. In TRIPLES 2 triples: one mixed, and one freely formed triple.
- 4.6. During the Doubles and Triples games, one player in each team may be replaced. For the Mixed Doubles and Mixed Triples teams the replacement shall not affect the mixed composition of the team. The replacement can only be made between the two ends and must be reported to the captain of the opposing team and the umpire. A player that has completed their game or has been replaced cannot play in any other team during this round.

#### **5. Points and Winner**

- 5.1. Winning a singles game gives 2 Game points (max 12pt).
- 5.2. Winning a doubles game gives 3 Game points (max 9pt).
- 5.3. Winning a triples game gives 5 Game points (max 10pt).
- 5.4. The team with the most Game points at the end of the match is awarded 3 Match points.
- 5.5. The team that have the most Match points is the winner of a group.
- 5.6. If two or more teams have the same total number of Match points in a group, the following formula will be applied to decide the overall results:
  - 1) The sum of Game points only between those teams;
  - 2) The difference of small points (game results (13:1 or 9:8)) between those teams;
  - 3) Total small points (game results (13:1 or 9:8)) difference between all teams.

**Issues not covered by this Regulation shall be governed by the EuroCup Qualification Rules.**
